

PICTURE IT

INSTRUCTIONS

AGES: 8 and up

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 4 or more, divided into two teams

EQUIPMENT: 50 two-sided cards (5 Picture It words on each side of the card), 1 pencil, 1 notepad

OBJECT: Be the team to guess the most number of Picture It words.

SET-UP: Divide into two teams. Decide which side of the cards will be played (blue or yellow). The team with the youngest player will be Team A, and Team A will choose a member of their team to be the Artist for the first round.

PLAY: The Artist takes a card and looks at the colored side that is being played (making sure no other player can see that side). The Artist looks at the first word on that side, places the card face down on a nearby surface, and then draws the first word using the pencil and paper. When drawing, the Artist can draw anything they want except for numbers or letters. The Artist also cannot say

anything or make noises, except for stating "correct" when one team guesses the word correctly. The first team to guess the word correctly "wins" the word. After one team guesses the first word, the Artist then looks at the second word on the card and draws it. The first team to guess it correctly wins the word. If one player from each team says aloud the correct answer at the same time, neither team wins that word. This continues until the Artist has drawn all 5 words on that side of the card. The team that wins the most number of words wins that card, placing it in a scoring pile near their team.

For the second round, Team B provides the Artist. A new card is chosen and play continues as described above. Teams alternate throughout the rest of the game, and Artists change from turn to turn.

THE WINNER: After a predetermined number of cards have been played (20 cards is recommended), the team with the most cards in their scoring pile is the winner.
