1000 KIDS TRIVIA QUESTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: One or more.

EQUIPMENT: 1000 trivia questions in a deck of 50 cards.

OBJECT: To win the most cards.

PLAY: Place the card deck in the center of the play area. Decide which number set to play (i.e., all the number 1 questions, or all the number 2 questions, etc.). The oldest player has first turn. Turns then pass to the left. In your turn you take the top card from the deck and read aloud the question (number 1 if you are playing all number 1 questions). The player to your left becomes the guessing player and must answer your question with either A, B, or C. The answer is indicated in bold immediately following the question. If correct, the guessing player wins the card. If not, you set the card aside, out of play. In either case, the guessing player now becomes the reader (same number question on the next card), and the player to his left becomes the new guessing player. Play continues to the left until all 50 cards have been played. The player with the most cards is the winner.

EASY VERSION: All rules remain the same, except that the guessing player may ask the reader to eliminate one of the two false answers among the A, B, C.
